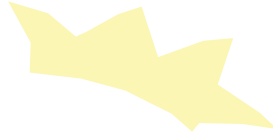

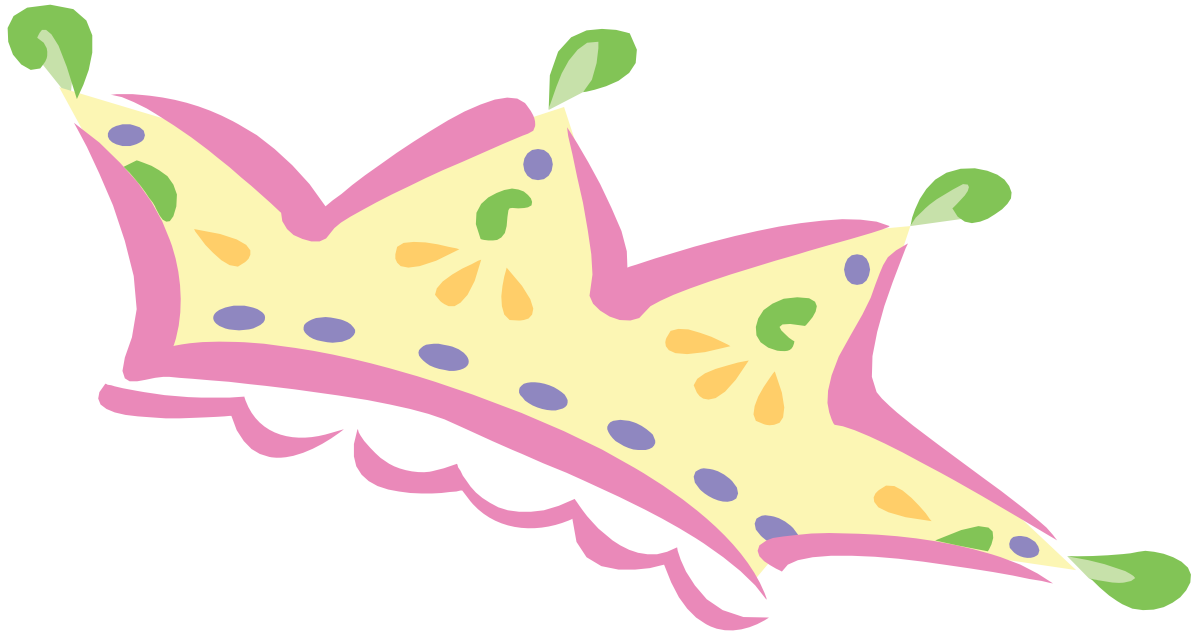

SEASONAL EMPLOYMENT

The St. Mary's AFS Program is looking to hire an individual to fill a position at the Mactaquac Hatchery.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Mary's Band Member
- Clean Criminal Record Check
- Fingerprinting
- Credit Check (May be done on-line)

TASK DESCRIPTION:

- Feed fish and record feed usage daily
- Daily clean and monitor ponds, removing and recording any mortalities
- Assist with treating fish to prevent fungal and bacterial infections by use of mixed salt baths
- Spawning of salmon and care of eggs including picking, transfer and inventories
- Adult salmon pond inventory
- Any other related duties required

EXPECTED RESULTS:

- Workers gain experience in many aspects of hatchery work (an advantage when seeking long term employment)

This is a 25 week seasonal employment opportunity with a start date beginning around the 1st of May, 2018. 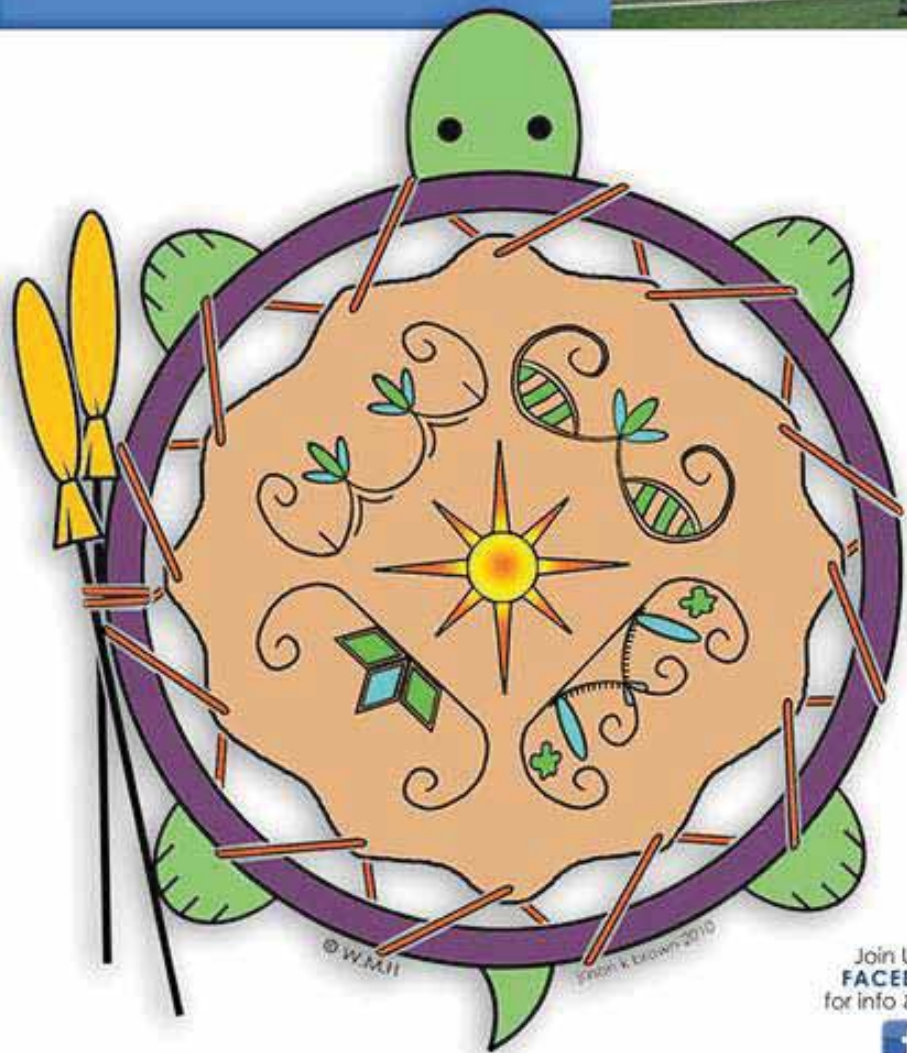
