ABORIGINAL FIELD WORKER

TransCanada Pipelines Limited in partnership with Stantec Consulting and Green Eagle Services is currently accepting applications from highly motivated, enthusiastic Aboriginal candidates within New Brunswick interested in participating in its 2015 archaeological shovel testing program.

Work is expected to start in early September and last until late November. Workers may be required to travel to worksites throughout the province.

Shovel testing involves the excavation, primarily with shovels, of 50 cm x 50 cm test pits and the screening of sediments from those test pits through wire mesh to inspect for archaeological or cultural heritage resources. Mapping, flagging and other archaeological techniques may also be used. Fieldworkers will be responsible for weekly activity reporting and participating in activity reporting to First Nations in New Brunswick.

The Aboriginal Field Worker program offers opportunities for Aboriginal participants to gain hands-on experience alongside trained archaeologists and knowledgeable field technicians.

In addition to providing employment, the Aboriginal Field Worker program is designed to engage, develop and guide Aboriginal careers by:

- Utilizing and building on existing Aboriginal skills and knowledge
- Providing professional guidance, training and mentoring opportunities

Experience in fieldwork or archaeology is preferred, but not considered essential; pre-field and on-the-job training will be provided by Field Directors and Supervisors.
