Addiction Mental Wellness Worker

Under the general supervision of the Health Director, the Addiction Mental Wellness Worker will provide support services and education that are culturally sensitive, help improve the mental health and wellbeing of SMFN Members. This position will be responsible to provide client services (individual, group, advocacy and case management) as well as prevention programming at the community level related to addictions and mental wellness. This will involve direct contact with clients involving assessment, peer counselling, referrals, case management, and aftercare. Other programming may include facilitation of support groups and working with all ages in prevention activities
