Anyone interested in taking part in this event **MUST** register on Thursday, October.13th between 3pm and 5pm at the SMFN Culture Center. Moose Hunt Rules:

- Must be 16 years of age and possess a SMFN band card
- Entry fee of \$50 to be paid by 5:00 pm on Thursday October 13th. If no payment received we will not take your moose. No exceptions.
- Absolutely no cows!
- No night hunting.
- All registered moose will be taken to Carr's Meat Shop in Woodstock, NB. Gas vouchers will be given to those who register their moose.
- Carr's will notify organizers of rotten meat and the hunters who register the moose will be disqualified.
- Moose must be brought in whole, not quarters.
- Moose must be registered by Megan Fullarton or Jesse Paul no later than 2pm on October.16th.
- Registered moose will be donated to SMFN. The first 10 moose will be registered for seniors. Any moose after that will be taken to the butcher at the hunters own expense but we will still provide a \$50 gas voucher. (This is to ensure we do not have an over-abundance of moose shot, so for example when we get up to 8 moose the hunters will need to decide if their bull is large enough to potentially place in the competition and if not, then leave it in the woods.)
- One (1) moose registered per participant.
- Points must be at least a half inch (1/2) to count.
- Horns must be kept. There will be a gathering at the lower parking lot on Sunday October.16th at 3pm to verify total number of points.
- All participants will receive a registration package which will include a tobacco offering for your moose and other items.
