Under the general supervision of the Chief Harold Sappier Memorial School Principal the Numeracy Lead Teacher is responsible for providing daily Numeracy instruction to students in accordance with the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework. In addition to providing Numeracy support through individual and small group instruction, the Numeracy Lead may also be expected to perform some classroom teaching responsibilities. The Teacher is the educational leader in the classroom and will ensure that the school's program and curricula are implemented in a way that maximizes student learning. The Teacher is responsible for the supervision and evaluation of all students within his/her teaching assignment. Working collaboratively in a team environment, the Numeracy Lead Teacher will demonstrate a strong commitment to the planning and delivery of early literacy support and classroom instruction and reports directly to the Principal.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate shall possess a minimum of a Bachelor of Education Degree and holds a valid teacher's license granted under the authority of the Minister of Education of the Province of New Brunswick. The successful candidate must also provide a clean criminal record check. Previous experience in teaching elementary grade levels would be an asset.
